Tools and materials

- Crochet hook 2.0mm and 2.5mm
- Yarn – I use Gazzal Jeans, Etrofil Jeans or Alize Cotton Gold – colors of your choice. You can also use analogs (100g/330m).
- Stuffing material
- Safety eyes 3D 16mm
- Safety nose
- Buttons for the shorts
- Black thread for paws, eyebrow and lashes embroidery
- Pink thread for lips embroidery
- Needle
- Stitch marker
- Blush to color the cheeks
- Scissors
- Pompon 3-4cm to make the tail
- Ribbon to make a bow
- Sushi chopstick and ribbon bow for the heart
- Tip: You can use any type/size of yarn and crochet hook to improve the quality of the toy.

Abbreviations

Mr – magic ring

Ch – chain

Ss – slip stich

Sc – single crochet

Hdc – half double crochet

Inc – increase (2sc stiches in the same stitch)

Dec – decrease (2 stiches crocheted together)

(...)* n – repeat what is inside (...) symbols number of times n specified in pattern

BLO – back loops only

Details

Head

1. 6sc in the magic ring
2. inc*6 (12)
3. (sc, inc)*6 (18)
4. sc, inc, (2sc, inc)*5, sc (24)
5. (3sc, inc)*6 (30)
6. 2sc, inc, (2sc, inc)*5, 2sc (36)
7. (5sc, inc)*6 (42)
8. 3sc, inc, (2sc, inc)*5, 3sc (48)
9. (7sc, inc)*6 (54)
- 10-14. 54sc
15. 4sc, inc, (8sc, inc)*5, 4sc (60)
16. (9sc, inc)*6 (66)
17. 5sc, inc, (10sc, inc)*5, 5sc (72)
- 18-23. 72sc (6 rounds)
24. 5sc, dec, (10sc, dec)*5, 5sc (66)
25. (9sc, dec)*6 (60)
26. 4sc, dec, (8sc, dec)*5, 4sc (54)
27. (7sc, dec)*6 (48)
28. 24dec

Place the eyes between 14 and 15 row. The distance is 13sc.

Fasten the thread and cut it off.

Fill the head with fiberfill.



Left ear

Each ear contains of two parts.

Crochet in rows.

Chain 2 and crochet 2sc in the second chain

1. inc, sc, ch
2. 3sc, ch
3. inc, 2sc, ch

4. 4sc, ch
5. inc, 3sc, ch
6. 5sc, ch
7. inc, 4sc, ch
8. 6sc, ch
9. inc, 5sc, ch
10. 7sc, ch
11. inc, 6sc, ch
12. 8sc, ch
13. inc, 7sc, ch
14. 9sc, ch
15. inc, 8sc, ch
16. 10sc, ch
17. inc, 9sc, ch
18. 11sc, ch
19. inc, 10sc, ch
20. 12sc, ch
21. inc, 11sc, ch
22. 13sc, ch
23. inc, 12sc, ch
24. 14sc, ch
25. 3sc, 4dec, 3sc, ch
26. 10sc, ch
27. sc, 4dec, sc, ch
28. 6sc, ch

Crochet 1 piece in body color (use 2.5mm crochet hook) and one piece in contrasting color (use 2.0mm crochet hook). Now put both parts together and crochet 2 rounds with sc. On the corners make inc with 3sc. Fold the ear and sew it.

Right ear

Crochet in rows.

Chain 2 and crochet 2sc in the second chain

1. sc, inc, ch
2. 3sc, ch
3. 2sc, inc, ch
4. 4sc, ch
5. 3sc, inc, ch
6. 5sc, ch
7. 4sc, inc, ch
8. 6sc, ch
9. 5sc, inc, ch
10. 7sc, ch
11. 6sc, inc, ch
12. 8sc, ch
13. 7sc, inc, ch
14. 9sc, ch
15. 8sc, inc, ch
16. 10sc, ch
17. 9sc, inc, ch
18. 11sc, ch
19. 10sc, inc, ch
20. 12sc, ch

21. 11sc, inc, ch
22. 13sc, ch
23. 12sc, inc, ch
24. 14sc, ch
25. 3sc, 4dec, 3sc, ch
26. 10sc, ch
27. sc, 4dec, sc, ch
28. 6sc, ch

Crochet 1 piece in body color (use 2.5mm crochet) and one piece in contrasting color (use 2.0mm crochet). Now put both parts together and crochet 2 rounds with sc. On the corners make inc with 3sc. Fold the ear and sew it.



Arms (2psc)

Crochet in body color.

1. 6sc in the magic ring
2. inc*6 (12)
3. (inc, 3sc)*3 (15)
- 4-5. 15sc
5. 5sc, 4dc bobble stitch in one sc, 9sc
6. 15sc
7. (dec, 3sc)*5 (12)

Change color every 2 rows to make striped sleeves.

8. 12sc (You can crochet a few sc in body color, so the color change is placed on the opposite side from the thumb.)
9. 12sc BLO
- 10-24. 12sc

Stuff the palms tightly, then do not fill the arms. Fold the arms and crochet 6sc.

Back to the row 9 and make ruffle - 1ch, 2hdc in the same stitch, then make ss and repeat 2hdc, ss till the end. Tie the threads and hide them inside the arm. To make ruffle use 2.5mm crochet hook and crochet loosely. The ruffle will be exposed nicely.



Legs (2psc)

Foot

1. 6sc in the MR
2. 6inc (12)
3. (sc, inc)*6 (18)
4. (inc, 2sc)*6 (24)
5. (3sc, inc)*6 (30)
- 6-7. 30sc (2 rounds)
8. (3sc, dec)*6 (24)
- 9-11. 24sc (3 rounds)
12. (2sc, dec)*6 (18)
13. 5sc BLO, 12sc, sc BLO (18)
14. 5sc, sc BLO, 12sc (18)
15. 5sc BLO, 13sc (18)
16. 9dec (9)

Fill the foot with fiberfill and flatten in a little bit.

Fasten off leaving the short yarn tail. Using needle, weave the yarn tail through the front loop of each remaining stitch and pull it tight, closing of the foot. Weave in the yarn end.

Leg

Now we go back to BLO stitches in rows 13, 14 and 15. Hold the foot with the toes up attach the thread with ch1 and crochet 12sc starting with the 5sc of the 15 round of the palm and crochet clockwise 6sc, then turn the foot, so that the heel is up and crochet 6sc. Join the round and put the marker.

2. (inc, 3sc)*3 (15)
 - 3-7. 15sc (5 rounds)
 8. (inc, 4sc)*3 (18)
 - 9-11. 18 sc (3 rounds)
 12. (dec, sc)*6 (12)
 13. crochet 3, 4 or 5sc depending on how much inward facing you want feet to be
- Fill it with fiberfill. Fold in two and crochet 6sc together.
Embroider the paws.



Body

1. 6sc in the magic ring
 2. inc*6 (12)
 3. (sc, inc)*6 (18)
 4. sc, inc, (2sc, inc)*5, sc (24)
 5. (3sc, inc)*6 (30)
 6. 2sc, inc, (2sc, inc)*5, 2sc (36)
 7. (5sc, inc)*6 (42)
 8. 3sc, inc, (2sc, inc)*5, 3sc (48)
 9. (7sc, inc)*6 (54)
 10. 4sc, inc, (8sc, inc)*5, 4sc (60)
 - 11-13. 60sc
 14. 12sc, 6sc together with leg, 24sc, 6sc together with leg, 12sc (60)
 15. 18sc, (2sc, dec)*6, 18sc (54)
 - 16-17. 54
- Start changing colors every 2 rows to make stripes.
18. (7sc, dec)*6 (48)
 19. 48sc
 20. (6sc, dec)*6 (42)
 - 21 - 22. 42sc
 23. (5sc, dec)*6 (36)
 - 24-25. 36sc
 26. (4sc, dec)*6 (30)
 - 27-28. 30sc
 29. (3sc, dec)*6 (24)
 28. 24sc
 29. BLO 24sc
- Back to body color
- 30-31. 24sc

Fasten the thread, cut off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Hold the body upside down and in 29 row crochet ruffle. Chain 2, (2hdc in one stitch, ss) repeat till the end. Tie the threads and hide them inside the body. To make ruffle use 2.5mm crochet hook and crochet loosely. The ruffle will be exposed nicely. Fill the body with fiberfill.



Shorts

Use jeans yarn and crochet hook 2.5mm. Ch 50, close in a circle and crochet in a spiral.

1-21. 50sc

22. 28sc, do not finish the row.

Fold the shorts in 2 and sew 5 from the front part and 5 from the back part of the round 1 to make the legs of the shorts. The legs should be made of 20 stitches. 10 stitches will be the sewing place.

Now, back to the round 22 and crochet in turning rows. The centre of the front part of the shorts should be placed just in the middle. Maybe it would be necessary to crochet a few more or less stitches in the round 22.

Front part of the shorts:

1. 10sc, ch
2. dec, 6sc, dec, ch
3. 8sc, ch
4. dec, 4sc, dec, ch
5. 6sc

Fasten off and leave about 20cm of the thread to sew the buttons with it. Cut and secure the thread.

Assembly the thread in 21sc of the round 31 and crochet 1 sc around the front part of the shorts. Then, crochet sc to the back of the shorts and make suspenders. (Crochet 24ch, 5hdc starting from the second chain, chain 1, skip 1 sc, 17hdc, ss in the next sc), ss, repeat (...). Fasten the thread and secure it inside the shorts.



Heart

1. 6 sc in the magic ring
2. 6inc (12)
3. (inc, sc)*6 (18)

4. (2sc, inc)*6 (24)

5. (7sc, inc)*3 (27)

6. (8sc, inc)*3 (30)

7-8. 30sc

Fasten off and cut the yarn. Crochet the second part in the same way, but continue. Crochet 5sc together with first part. Continue crocheting around – you should have 50 sc (25sc of the first part and 25sc with the second one).

9-11. 50sc

12. (8sc, dec)*5 (45)

13. 45sc

14. (7sc, dec)*5 (40)

15. 40sc

16. (6sc, dec)*5 (35)

17. 35sc

18. (5sc, dec)*5 (30)

19. 30sc

20. (sc, dec)*10

21. 10dec

Fill it with fiberfill. Fasten off leaving the short yarn tail. Using needle, weave the yarn tail through the front loop of each remaining stitch, put the sushi chopstick inside the bottom of the heart and pull it tight, closing of the foot. Weave in the yarn end. Make a ribbon bow on the chopstick.

Toy assembly



1. Attach the head to the body (remember to fill the neck tightly with fiberfill. If you don't do this, your head will bob).
2. Sew the arms symmetrically to the body just under the ruffle.
3. To shape the face, take a long, strong thread in the same color as the head. Then, starting at the neck, pull the thread to the eye area (in my case, this is the outer corner of the eyes). Insert the needle about 2sc below and return to the neck area. Do the same with the other eye. Now pull the thread very tightly and tie it. You can repeat these steps if you like. Hide the thread inside the head. Do the same with the inner part of the eyes, but with one thread. Do the same with the centre (in the lower part of the eye) and glue the nose. You can also embroider it.
TIP: I encourage you to experiment with face shaping – each time you will create a bunny with a different character. It all depends on your imagination, the tension of the thread, the size of the eyes, or using a different method for embroidering the eyebrows, eyelashes and mouth. You'll see how much fun it will be.
4. Embroider the lips.
5. Embroider the lashes and eyebrows.
6. Attach the ears symmetrical on the head, tail and bow.
